What Is Blu-Ray?

Blu-Ray disks are the same physical size and shape as a DVD but have a far higher data density than that of a DVD. This allows for us to provide a higher quality video file than we could ever provide on a DVD.

What Do I Need to Play It?

You will need a Blu-Ray player.



There are many set top boxes on the market today that provide Blu-Ray playback. Somewhere on the box you should be able to see a Blu-Ray logo like the one on the left.

If you have a Playstation 3, Xbox one, Playstation 4. These do, or will come with a Blu-Ray player already built in. You won't require anything else to get started.

So What's It Going To Cost Me?

Blu-Ray disks cost more than DVD's. This is just a factor of how they are made. There will be extra cost over that of the DVD version. Because the shows we record vary in length some products may require more than one disk, or require the use of a larger Blu-Ray disk.
